Testing

Once your paperwork is nearing completion, call or come to us to schedule a test date. As part of our A&S process, you will be given a series of tests, including a PFT, Typing, Geography (Countries and Captials of the Middle East and surrounding region), Spelling, Modified BST, Land Navigation, and Military Symbols. Study guides for these tests are located in the "Study Material" section of this webpage. There are no "multiple choice" questions on any of our tests.

Upon completion of the tests, we will issue you a writing assignment and schedule a date for you to stand an A&S board. The board will determine your eligibility for lateral move into the 0211 MOS.

FAQ

"I have questions about my paperwork/testing/study guides/eligibility/the board/etc, what do I do?"
