Subj: FUND DRIVE ASSIGNMENTS

1. Purpose. To publish section assignments for the conduct of the Navy Marine Corps Relief (NMCR) fund drive and Combined Federal Campaign (CFC).
2. Background. Various campaigns and fund drives are conducted throughout the calendar year to offer our Marines opportunities to provide for themselves and others. While these campaigns are worth-while and deserve special attention and support, they are labor intensive. Thus, it is the policy of this Command to divide the responsibilities and rotate the assignment of staff sections for the NMCR fund drive and CFC fund drive throughout the year.
3. Information. Historically, the NMCR fund drive goes in the spring and the Combined Federal Campaign in the fall of the year. CG, I MEF normally receives notification of the upcoming campaign by letter. This notification will be forwarded to the tasked section which will then be responsible for assigning an Action Officer for the campaign.
