

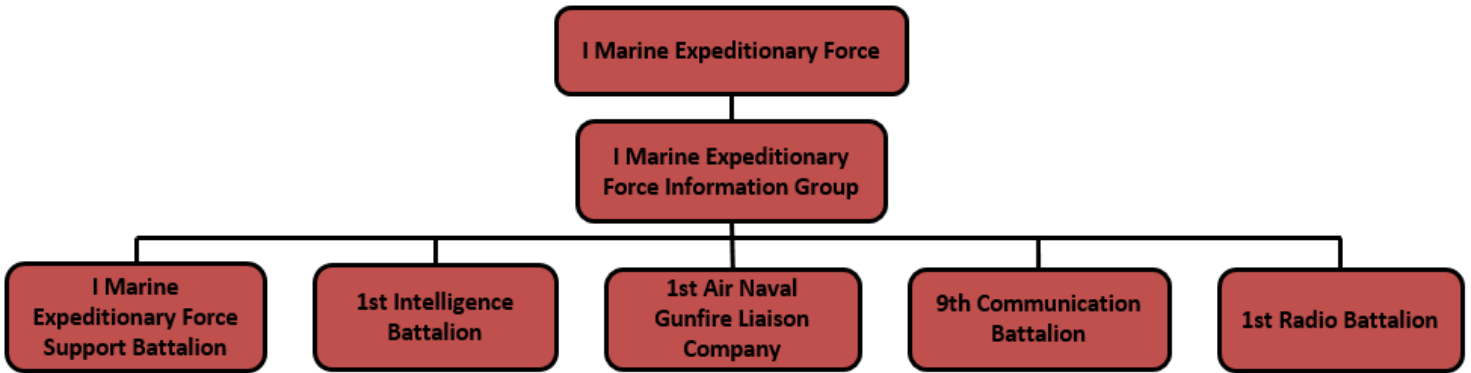
I Marine Expeditionary Force Information Group Welcome Aboard
